## Ocean Wise Lunch Box Challenge Definitions and Examples

| Type of plastic waste | Definition | Examples |

| Food wrappers | Wrappers can hold an individual serving of food or many, and sometimes have a shiny backing | - Granola bar wrappers <br> - Stand-up pouches (often resealable) <br> - Yogurt seals (lids on yogurt cup) <br> - Sandwich bags (like Ziploc) |
| Soft plastic packaging | If you can crumple the plastic up into a ball, it's soft packaging | - Bread bags <br> - Plastic overwrap (like on packs of juice boxes) <br> - Saran wrap |
| Hard plastic packaging | If you can't crumple it up into a ball, it's hard packaging | - Clamshell packaging (like berries or muffins) <br> - Yogurt cups <br> - Plastic takeout containers |
| Bottles and bottle caps | Bottles contain drinks. Count the bottle and its cap as two separate items. | - Pop and water bottles <br> - Drinkable yogurt bottles <br> - Chocolate milk bottles |
| Tetrapaks/cartons | Tetrapaks contain drinks and other liquids. They are shaped like boxes. Count straws or caps separately. | - Juice boxes and cartons <br> - Milk/plant-based milk cartons |
| Plastic dishware | Cups, plates, or bowls that are made of plastic or paper with a plastic coating. | - Solo cups <br> - Paper dishes (like Starbucks cups or paper plates with a plastic coating) <br> - Paper takeout boxes |
| Plastic utensils | Plastic tools to help you eat your food | - Forks, knives, spoons, chopsticks, etc. |
| Plastic drink accessories | Plastic drink lids and straws (including straws from juice boxes) | - Plastic coffee lids, pop lids and straws |
| Stickers | Found on fruit and vegetables | - Apple, avocado, banana stickers |
| Plastic foam products | Foam products are brittle (snap easily), are usually white or black, and are often used as trays | - Meat/sandwich trays <br> Takeout containers Styrofoam coffee cups |
| Plastic bags | Thin, flexible bags with handles to carry your food | - Grocery store bags <br> - Restaurant take-out bags |
| Plastic can holders | Flexible plastic rings used to carry cans | - Rings around a six-pack of pop |
| Multi-material packaging | Packaging that is made of more than one type of material | - Carboard box with a plastic window, like pasta <br> - Blister packs (like for gum) <br> - Tea bags (plastic mesh with tea leaves inside) |
| Other | Anything that doesn't have a defined category or that you're not sure about. |  |
